Eye Test Clinic

There will be an BVA/KC/ISDS approved Eye Test Clinic held during the BTA Championship Show on 10th October 2009 at Middleton Cheney.

Bedlington Terriers tested at this official clinic will have their results printed in the Breed Records Supplement and be included on KC computer records. Breeders striving for Accredited Breeder status are required to have their breeding stock tested before registering.

The cost of the test is £26 per dog which is the cost of the test @ £23 plus a contribution towards the Vets travelling expenses and hire of the venue.

The charge of £26 is possible only if the number of dogs for testing is 25 or more. The Bedlington Terrier Health Group is very keen to support this Clinic and is guaranteeing the basic price of £26 per dog.

Testing will begin at 11am and finishes about 4pm. The test requires the use of eye drops so show dogs are usually tested after showing. Non show dogs are tested at other times during the clinic.

Owners of dogs being tested need to bring the KC Registration Document for each dog.
