A lot of Bedlington folk arrive on the Friday and make a weekend of the FUN DAY. On the Saturday there's ample time to walk your dogs, visit Banbury or Shipston or go to the very large outdoor market at Wellesbourne. Later on the Saturday afternoon there's normally a short walk through the fields ending up at a house full of Bedlingtons for nibbles and a glass or two. Back at the camping field there's always various groups chatting, having Barbies, a glass or two and generally having a sociable evening.

Sunday the FUN DAY starts around 10am with folk and their dogs who have travelled to Brailes for the day meeting up for coffee and to meet up with the other Bedlingtons already there. There will be judged fun classes, some Bedlington and Lurcher racing and a noted working Bedlington and Lurcher owner will judge a class for working dogs. If you would like to try and get your dog through the Good Citizen award there's a class held for the Bronze.
